

## Dance and Descriptive Writing

- 1. Discuss the differences between sustained and percussive movements
- 2. View a demonstration dance containing both types of movement
- 3. Make two lists of verbs, one sustained, the other percussive
- 4. Provide a topic for the dance
- 5. Working in groups of six, students select two percussive and two sustained verbs from the list as well as a fifth verb which may be either
- Using an ABBA pattern, three members of the group perform 8 counts of a percussive movement, the other three members respond with an 8 count sustained movement
- 7. The second group then performs 8 counts of percussive movement, the first group responds with 8 counts of sustained movement
- 8. An 8 count ending is either sustained or percussive and brings the two groups together or further separates them
- The group of six creates one or two paragraphs using the five verbs and adding adverbs to describe the movements in detail or create metaphors, similes or poetry
- 10. Share the writing with the entire group
